

# Imaging Services Accreditation Scheme

## Are you interested in becoming an ISAS Lay Assessor?

ISAS is a new **patient focussed** imaging services accreditation scheme that is independently assessed against a quality enhancing standard that is based on clinical and patient reported performance measures. **ISAS gives confidence** to patients, purchasers, staff, and managers about safety, effectiveness and sustainability of the service.

The United Kingdom Accreditation Service (UKAS), appointed by The Royal College of Radiologists and The Society and College of Radiographers to manage and deliver the new imaging services accreditation scheme, is looking to recruit and train individuals to become Lay Assessors and work as integral members of each assessment team alongside radiographers and radiologists.

For your contribution you will be paid a nominal fee and should be able to commit to a minimum of two assessments per year.

Lay assessors are drawn from the general public and will have experience as patient representatives, such as members of a recognised local, regional or national patient group, or will have an interest in healthcare delivery.

The ideal candidate should possess sound reasoning and good interpersonal and IT skills. Access to a PC with broadband facilities is essential as much of the review and preparation will be online. Also some travel in the UK, and overnight stays will be required, but will be kept as local as possible.
